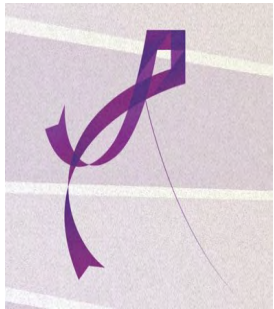

Jamestown, ND

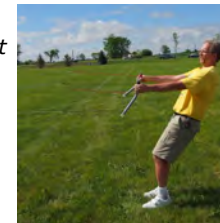
